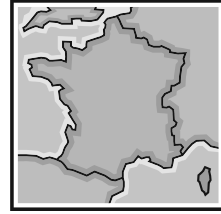


Français III

Syllabus



La description:

Level III French is an honors course, which incorporates the previously acquired knowledge and skills into the beginnings of a whole-language communication tool. Greater emphasis is put on development of reading and writing in addition to the listening and speaking skills targeted in Levels I and II. Level III sets the stage for communication, strengthens proficiency through meaningful communicative contexts, builds vocabulary for success from recognition to production, follows a clear lesson progression to build in success, presents grammar concepts visually to improve comprehension and retention, improves students' reading skills, provides opportunities for students to experience different cultures, follows each unit of study with diagnostic reviews and cultivates better writers through a developed writing process. This course involves research activities, which generally have cultural themes.
