Français I Syllabus



Description:

Level I French is a foundation course with the purpose of developing the fundamentals of language acquisition. Study covers language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing), grammar, vocabulary and culture. Level 1 helps the student begin to develop the ability to communicate effectively, using the target language. The integration of various supplemental learning aids and technology tools (audio, video and computer programs) help stimulate and encourage learning. Level I lays the foundation for study in Level II.
