You will concentrate on the design of web pages and the technical issues impacting your design. You will be using web-authoring software to create your pages, with some need to program in HTML. Our goal is to link technical proficiency and creative comprehension. The second section concentrates on Video Editing. The class will concentrate specifically on digitizing audio and video used in commercials and music video production.
