

Creative Fashions I

Term(s) – 1 Semester

TEXT: Clothing: Fashion, Fabrics and Construction

PREREQUISITE: None

DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to aid students with wardrobe planning, the study of fabrics, basic textile information, buying skills, care of clothing, basic sewing/embroidery skills and careers associated with textiles and clothing. Students will create a variety of projects from personal use clothing to home decor sewing.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Identify in writing the basic parts of all **sewing** equipment used and demonstrate their function.
- Demonstrate performance, maintenance, care and safety procedures of all equipment.
- Choose patterns that are suitable for the various figure types.
- Demonstrate the ability to choose appropriate fabric for the pattern of their choosing.
- Locate pattern layout and follow straight of grain arrows to pin patterns to fabric.
- Demonstrate proper cutting procedures.
- Determine proper marking technique suited for fabric.
- **Identify and practice laundry care, ironing, and stain removal for all types of fabrics and clothing**
- Design and sew projects with the computerized embroidery machines.
