The Concert Band is open to all students who have at least some grade school band experience or have gone through the beginning band program at the high school. The types of music selected and studied will be challenging and varied based upon the instrumentation and skills of the group. The director will assign students to chairs. Some audition may be required. Private instruction is recommended for all students. Regular outside of class performances will be a part of class requirements Membership in the Symphonic Band is by audition and/or director's recommendation. Those accepted have the ability to play more difficult literature, including all styles from classical to pop. The directors will assign students to this ensemble after they have met the requirements, within the parameters of available chairs. Instrumentation will be limited to wind ensemble size. Private instruction is encouraged and expected of all members. Regular outside of class performances will be a part of course requirements
