

Illinois Central College Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and Fire Science Program Early College



What:

An ICC Early College program in which high school seniors will participate in three certification courses, CPR, EMR & EMT, and two Fire Science courses as Illinois Central College students. Students will attend class in East Peoria at the Folepi Building, 2200 E.

Washington St, East Peoria, IL.

When:

August 17, 2020 – May 17, 2021 (ICC academic calendar) Classes meet 7:30 am – 10:00 am Monday-Friday

Why:

To give students the opportunity to become CPR certified personnel, licensed Emergency Medical Responders (EMRs), and licensed Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs). They will also be introduced to the operations and services provided by today's fire service professional, earning 6 college credits toward the Fire Science Technology degree

More:

To help students learn about emergency and fire services, and giving them a head start on a career in public safety. They will earn credentials that can lead to employment after high school graduation and licensure, such as an EMT, and/or continued education in Fire Science Technology, Emergency Medical Services, or related field

Where:

Folepi Building at 2200 E. Washington St. in East Peoria, IL 61611, and various participating fire departments

What:

.5 college credits for HLTH 041 – CPR course
2 college credits for EMS 112 – Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)
3 college credits for FRSTK 110 – Introduction to Fire Science

8 college credits for EMS 114 – Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) 3 college credits for FRSTK 113 – Fire Company Apparatus & Procedure

How:

Work with high school advisement/counseling staff to see if program will fit student's schedule

Complete ICC student application (icc.edu/apply) and EMS/Fire Science application

Participate in placement testing through ICC. Students must have a minimum Accuplacer reading score of 237, or a Writeplacer minimum score of 5. They can also qualify with a SAT reading score of 480 or ACT reading score of 18

Students must attend a mandatory orientation. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend with student.
