

Driver Education sequence, permit process, and frequently asked questions :

- All students are enrolled by birthdate. Oldest first, then if a spot opens up within the first week, that spot is offered to the next oldest in line. Class enrollment dates change due to drops, transfers, and other circumstances.
- Permits will be offered to all students 30 days prior to starting the class. For example, 1st quarter students will be eligible for permits mid July, 2nd quarter- mid September, 3rd quarter- early December, 4th quarter- mid February, summer school- late April. This helps students get started on the minimum nine month requirement of holding a permit before receiving a driver's licence.
- If your birthdate is at the beginning of the set enrollment, chances are that a spot will open up and you will have the option to move up into the earlier quarter.
- Summer school currently has 40 spots available. The first 40 to accept the summer school class is the limit. Based on previous enrollments- it has taken 75 students to find the 40 students to fill the class.
- Summer school schedule starts on the first day of summer and ends the second week of July. Two absences are allowed.
- All students under the age of 18 must hold their permit a minimum of nine months to be eligible to get their license. If a student is dropped from class, the permit is revoked and held out of class until the next semester.
